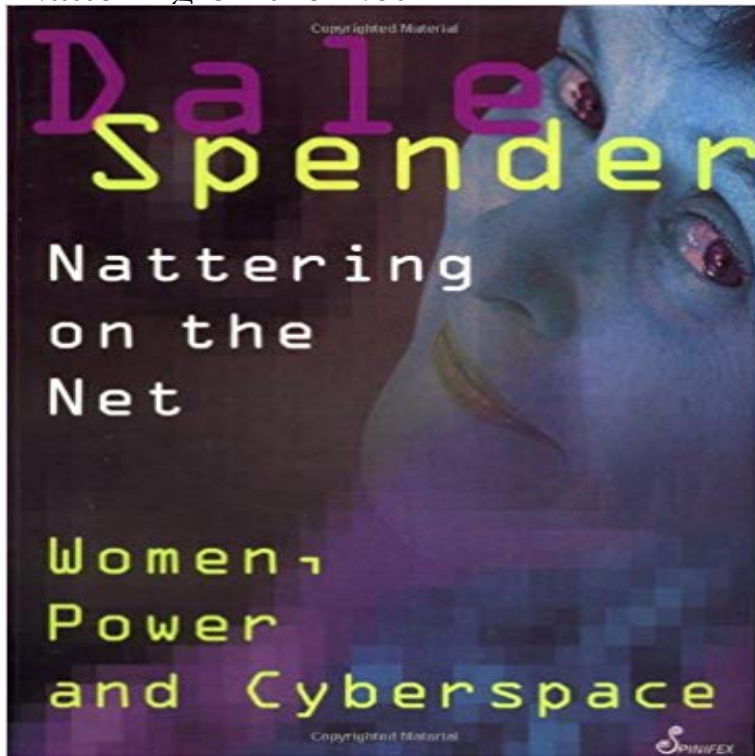


Nattering on the Net
