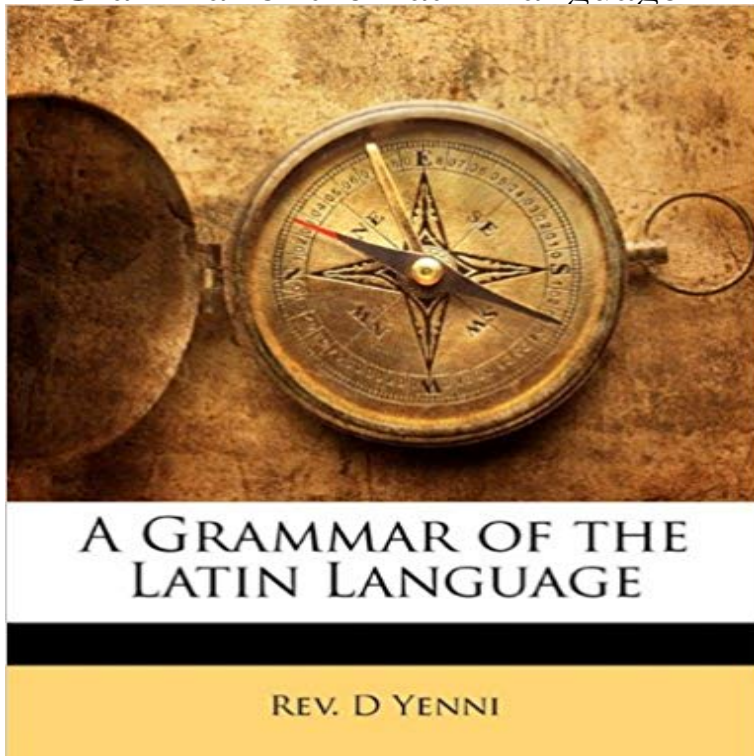


## A Grammar of the Latin Language
